

Additional information and Materials list for Glass Jewellery Class in June for the website.

What is the course About?

This hands-on day workshop will introduce you to materials and techniques used for Glass Fusing and in particular jewellery. You will explore basic glass cutting, patterns and specialist glass such as: Dichroic glass, stringers, Frit, Millefiori and marble effects.

- Produce effective jewellery designs.
- Demonstrate an understanding of Glass pattern and design.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the practice and methods used in Glass fusing and design.
- Demonstrate technical skills in glass cutting and arrangement.
- Use materials and equipment safely and effectively.

You will design, create and produce fused glass jewellery such as a brooch, pendant, earrings or ring. Please note that the results of firing cannot be prescribed and results are normally seen as a pleasant surprise.

What previous knowledge, experience or qualifications do you need?

Beginners and those with some experience would benefit equally. You will learn in a friendly and professional environment with all appropriate Health and Safety provision with a combination of introductory talk, demonstration, practise with individual support, discussion and course notes to take away. You will develop technical proficiency and confidence in basic glass fusing, jewellery design and creation.

Everyone is welcome, however a degree of manual dexterity will be required.

What do I need to bring with me?

Please bring a notebook and pen. Novices please do not purchase specialist tools before the start of the course. Glass cutters will be provided.

All masks, gloves and ear defenders will be supplied if necessary.
