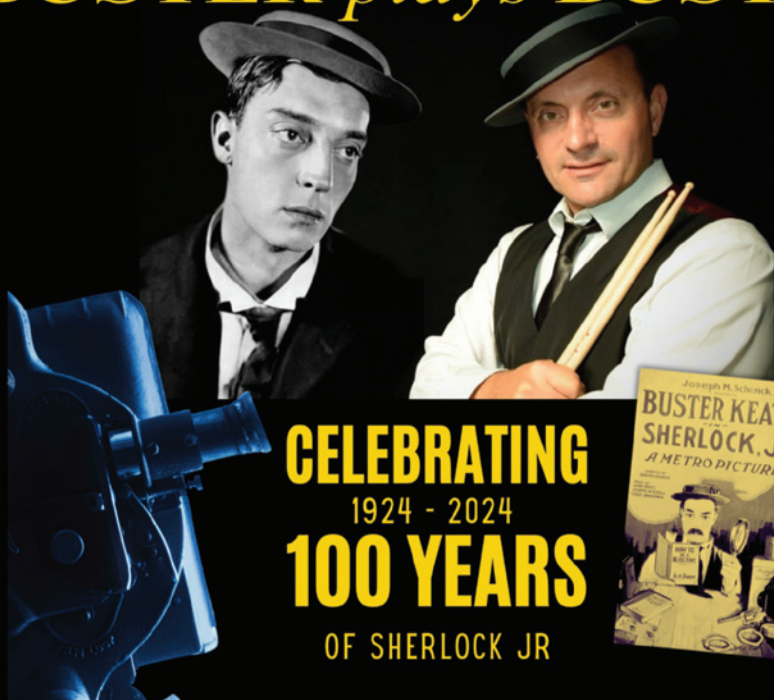


Music Bites
